COLLECTIBLE The vehicle must be currently branded as a collectible vehicle or the vehicle must follow procedures as outlined in Form MV-426B.

NOTE: The fee for any of the above registration plates is \$75.00 plus a certificate of title fee of \$22.50. The use of antique, classic and collectible plates is governed by Section 1340 of the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code which states: "It is unlawful for any person to operate a motorcycle or vehicle with antique, classic or collectible registration plates for general daily transportation. Permitted use shall be limited to participation in club activities, exhibits, tours, parades, occasional transportation and similar uses." **Occasional transportation and similar uses is defined as one day a week.**

Although buses and trucks are eligible for Antique and Classic plates, buses **MAY NOT** be used to transport passengers and trucks **MAY NOT** haul cargo.

Antique and Classic plates are not available for motorized pedalcycles or motorhomes.
